






PARTICIPANTS

One criterion in determining the participants will be a gender balance, and partners will be supported in achieving this balance.



Criteria:

- between 22-40 years old
- youth workers and young people who has experience on sustainability, ethical leadership, and inclusion

ACCOMMODATION

TRAVEL AND REIMBURSEMENT

Participants can check their flight tickets to Malta International Airport. You can reach at the accommodation with a direct bus from Airport to Marsaxlokk. **NOTE: YOU CAN BOOK YOUR ARRIVAL TICKET FOR 15 OR 16TH OF JUNE AND DEPARTURE TICKET FOR 22ND OF JUNE. IF THE TICKET ON 15TH OF JUNE IS CHEAPER YOU WILL BE ABLE TO ACCOMODATE IN THE PROJECT VENUE.**

You must choose the optimal tickets for your travel. **Please don't buy your tickets without confirmation from the project coordinator.** (Tickets that are bought without confirmation will not be reimbursed.)

Please do not use a taxi or private car, it is not an eligible cost, in case there are other options.

Never lose your boarding cards, e-tickets, invoices, and bus/train tickets, you will need your tickets the reimbursement.

TRAVEL REIMBURSEMENT WILL BE DONE A FEW MONTHS AFTER THE PROJECT ON THE BANK ACCOUNT OF TEAM LEADERS UPON RECEIVING ALL TICKETS, INVOICES, AND BOARDING PASSES AND ONLY AFTER PARTICIPANTS MAKE AT LEAST 1 DISSEMINATION (POSTS, REPORTS, OFFLINE EVENTS ETC) AND FILL PARTICIPANTS' REPORT

Participants are required to attend all the activities of the project and dissemination activities in your countries to get reimbursement.
